

DISCIPLINARY COMPLAINT RESOLUTION AGREEMENT

pursuant to section 55(2)(a.1) of the *Health Professions Act*

BETWEEN:

ANALIZA AL-SHAIBANY, #130,352
(the “**Registrant**”)

and

College of Registered Nurses of Alberta
(the “**College**”)

A Disciplinary Complaint Resolution Agreement (“**DCRA**”) was executed between the Registrant and the College, dated with effect March 12, 2024. The below constitutes a summary of such DCRA:

Through a Agreement with the College, Analiza Al-Shaibany, #130,352 (the “**Registrant**”), acknowledged and admitted that their behaviour constituted unprofessional conduct. Particulars of the Registrant’s unprofessional conduct arises from one (1) complaint to the College and includes the following:

- On or around July 29, 2023, the Registrant failed to declare during an attestation to the College of Registered Nurses of Alberta that they did not meet the currency of practice requirement on their initial application for a practice permit.
- On or around August 17, 2023, the Registrant failed to declare during an attestation to the College of Registered Nurses of Alberta that they did not meet the currency of practice requirement on their application for a permit renewal.
- On or around July 29, 2023, the Registrant failed to disclose during an attestation that she had previously been registered with the College of Registered Nurses of Saskatchewan and/or the Saskatchewan Registered Nurses Association and had conditions on her license in that jurisdiction, and consequently did not meet the good character requirements of the College of Registered Nurses of Alberta.
- On or around August 17, 2023, the Registrant failed to disclose during an attestation that she had previously been registered with the College of Registered Nurses of Saskatchewan and/or the Saskatchewan Registered Nurses Association and had conditions on her license in that jurisdiction, and consequently did not meet the good character requirements of the College of Registered Nurses of Alberta.

The Registrant agreed to pay a fine and requested that the Registrar remove their name from the register of the College. As a result, the Registrant’s registration and practice permit are rescinded.
