

# DISCIPLINARY COMPLAINT RESOLUTION AGREEMENT

pursuant to section 55(2)(a.1) of the *Health Professions Act*

**BETWEEN:**

**PAULINE AUGER, #56,127**  
(the “**Registrant**”)

and

**College and Association of Registered Nurses of Alberta**  
also known as **College of Registered Nurses of Alberta**  
(the “**College**”)

A Disciplinary Complaint Resolution Agreement (“**DCRA**”) was executed between the Registrant and the College, dated with effect **November 18, 2022**. The below constitutes a summary of such DCRA:

Through a DCRA with the College, PAULINE AUGER, #56,127 (the “**Registrant**”), acknowledged and admitted that their behaviour constituted unprofessional conduct. Particulars of the Registrant’s unprofessional conduct arises from one (1) complaint to the College include the following:

- In 2022 on one occasion while working for a community health care clinic, the Registrant failed to uphold the rights of medication administration and failed to demonstrate adequate judgment when they administered a patient with the incorrect medication, specifically when they administered an intramuscular injection of epinephrine via the patient’s intravenous line.

The Registrant agreed to complete course work and an essay on medication administration, pay a fine, and must provide a letter from any new employer for a period of time. Conditions shall appear on the College register and on the Registrant’s practice permit.
