



DISCIPLINARY COMPLAINT RESOLUTION AGREEMENT
pursuant to section 55(2)(a.1) of the *Health Professions Act*

BETWEEN:

TERRA MCKINNON #82,972
(the “**Regulated Member**”)

and

The College and Association of Registered Nurses of Alberta
(“**CARNA**”)

A Disciplinary Complaint Resolution Agreement (“**DCRA**”) was executed between the Regulated Member and CARNA, dated with effect **MAY 26, 2021**. The below constitutes a summary of such DCRA:

Through a DCRA with CARNA, TERRA MCKINNON, #82,972 (the “**Regulated Member**”), acknowledged and admitted that their behaviour constituted unprofessional conduct. Particulars of the Regulated Member’s unprofessional conduct arises from one (1) complaint to CARNA and includes the following:

- On approximately three occasions, although the Regulated Member understood that they had the permission and knowledge from the parents of the youths’ regarding their consumption of alcohol and marijuana, the Regulated Member failed to act professionally and participated in conduct that harms the integrity of the nursing profession, including: they permitted a youth, under the age of 18, to consume alcohol while the youth was, or appeared to be, intoxicated; they permitted a youth, under the age of 18, to consume marijuana while the youth was, or appeared to be, intoxicated; and they permitted and observed youths under the age of 18 to consume alcohol or marijuana.

The Regulated Member agreed to complete course work on professionalism and ethics, write a 2000-word essay and pay a fine. Conditions shall appear on the CARNA register and on the Regulated Member’s practice permit.
