

DISCIPLINARY COMPLAINT RESOLUTION AGREEMENT

pursuant to section 55(2)(a.1) of the *Health Professions Act*

BETWEEN:

HENNA KAUR, #137,940
(the “**Registrant**”)

and

College of Registered Nurses of Alberta
(the “**College**”)

A Disciplinary Complaint Resolution Agreement (“**DCRA**”) was executed between the Registrant and the College, dated with effect September 16, 2025. The below constitutes a summary of such DCRA:

“Through an Agreement with the College, HENNA KAUR, #137,940 (the “**Registrant**”), acknowledged and admitted that their behaviour constituted unprofessional conduct. Particulars of the Registrant’s unprofessional conduct arises from one (1) complaint to the College include the following:

- On or around between November 18, 2024 and March 19, 2025, the Registrant practiced as a RN and held themselves out to be an RN in good standing with CRNA, including providing patient care, without an active practice permit and when their practice permit was cancelled due to non-renewal
- On or about between March 7, 2025 and March 19, 2025, the Registrant demonstrated a lack of skill and/or judgment when they did one (1) or more of the following:
 - Failed to properly label medications;
 - Failed to complete an independent double check for midazolam; and
 - Mixed ketamine and ketolac while uncertified.

The Registrant agreed to complete coursework and a period of direct supervision followed by practice reports. Conditions shall appear on the College register and on the Registrant’s practice permit.”
