



AMENDED DISCIPLINARY COMPLAINT RESOLUTION AGREEMENT

pursuant to section 55(2)(a.1) of the *Health Professions Act*

BETWEEN:

BEVERLY WILLIAMS #76,327
(the “Regulated Member”)

and

The College and Association of Registered Nurses of Alberta
(“CARNA”)

An Amended Disciplinary Complaint Resolution Agreement (“ADCRA”) was executed between the Regulated Member and CARNA, dated with effect **December 2, 2020**. The below constitutes a summary of such ADCRA:

Through an ADCRA with CARNA, BEVERLY WILLIAMS, #76,327 (the “Regulated Member”), acknowledged and admitted that her behaviour constituted unprofessional conduct. Particulars of the Regulated Member’s unprofessional conduct arises from two (2) complaints to CARNA include the following:

- The Regulated Member failed to adequately document her assessments of patients, patient care plans, medication history or patient care during home visits on numerous occasions.
- The Regulated Member failed to apply her nursing knowledge and skill to provide safe, competent and ethical care to her patients during home visits on numerous occasions.
- The Regulated Member failed to adequately assess her patients during home visits on numerous occasions.
- The Regulated Member failed to prioritize the care of her patients when she did not conduct home visits on some occasions.
- The Regulated Member failed to prioritize the care of a patient who required care for his chest tube when she did not add them to their essential visit home care schedule and failed to use appropriate information and resources that enhance client care when she used an outdated essential visit home care schedule.

The Regulated Member agreed to complete coursework on documentation in nursing, assessment in nursing and critical thinking. In addition, she agreed to provide Performance Evaluations covering a total of 660 nursing practice hours. Conditions shall appear on the CARNA register and on the Regulated Member’s practice permit.
