



DISCIPLINARY COMPLAINT RESOLUTION AGREEMENT
pursuant to section 55(2)(a.1) of the *Health Professions Act*

BETWEEN:

JENNIFER JENNINGS #96,615
(the “Regulated Member”)

and

The College and Association of Registered Nurses of Alberta
(“CARNA”)

A Disciplinary Complaint Resolution Agreement (“**DCRA**”) was executed between the Regulated Member and CARNA, dated with effect **JUNE 21, 2021**. The below constitutes a summary of such DCRA:

Through a DCRA with CARNA, **JENNIFER JENNINGS, #96,615** (the “**Registrant**”), acknowledged and admitted that their behaviour constituted unprofessional conduct. Particulars of the Registrant’s unprofessional conduct arises from one (1) complaint to CARNA and includes the following:

- In 2018, the Registrant failed to demonstrate adequate judgment and failed to ensure a client’s right to confidentiality and privacy when they accessed personal health care information of five (5) people where there was no immediate care relationship.

The Registrant agreed to complete course work and pay a fine. Conditions shall appear on the CARNA register and on the Registrant’s practice permit.
