

DISCIPLINARY COMPLAINT RESOLUTION AGREEMENT

pursuant to section 55(2)(a.1) of the *Health Professions Act*

BETWEEN:

KARI SCINSKI, #87,996
(the “**Registrant**”)

and

College of Registered Nurses of Alberta
(the “**College**”)

A Disciplinary Complaint Resolution Agreement (“**DCRA**”) was executed between the Registrant and the College, dated with effect August 14, 2024. The below constitutes a summary of such DCRA:

“Through an Agreement with the College, KARI SCINSKI, #87,996 (the “**Registrant**”), acknowledged and admitted that their behaviour constituted unprofessional conduct. Particulars of the Registrant’s unprofessional conduct arises from one (1) complaint to the College include the following:

- Between approximately 2022 and 2023, the Registrant failed to act ethically and engaged in behavior that harms the integrity of the profession of registered nursing when they failed to notice but ought to have known approximately one hundred thirteen (113) false reimbursement claims were submitted on their behalf, for payment under their Alberta Blue Cross account, for treatments which had not been provided, and/or the claimed amounts were inflated, and the false claims resulted in overpayments to the Registrant.

The Registrant agreed to complete coursework and serve a period of suspension with a portion of the suspension held in abeyance for one (1) year. Conditions shall appear on the College register and on the Registrant’s practice permit.”
