



DISCIPLINARY COMPLAINT RESOLUTION AGREEMENT
pursuant to section 55(2)(a.1) of the *Health Professions Act*

BETWEEN:

DONG YOUN KIM #81,641
(the “Regulated Member”)

and

The College and Association of Registered Nurses of Alberta
(“CARNA”)

A Disciplinary Complaint Resolution Agreement (“**DCRA**”) was executed between the Regulated Member and CARNA, dated with effect **MAY 20, 2021**. The below constitutes a summary of such DCRA:

Through a DCRA with CARNA, **DONG YOUN KIM, #81,641** (the “**Registrant**”), acknowledged and admitted that their behaviour constituted unprofessional conduct. Particulars of the Registrant’s unprofessional conduct arises from two (2) complaints to CARNA include the following:

In or around 2020 and 2021, the Registrant diverted medication for their own use, left their unit to run an errand while the only RN on duty, and made a medication error, all of which are contrary to the *CNA Code of Ethics* and the *Practice Standards for Regulated Members*.

The Registrant agreed to complete course work, pay a fine, and provide a practice report letter from their employer. Conditions shall appear on the CARNA register and on the Registrant’s practice permit
