

# DISCIPLINARY COMPLAINT RESOLUTION AGREEMENT

pursuant to section 55(2)(a.1) of the *Health Professions Act*

**BETWEEN:**

**BASSEM ABDEL-RAHMAN, #113,749**  
(the “**Registrant**”)

and

**College and Association of Registered Nurses of Alberta**  
also known as **College of Registered Nurses of Alberta**  
(the “**College**”)

A Disciplinary Complaint Resolution Agreement (“**DCRA**”) was executed between the Registrant and the College, dated with effect **June 12, 2023**. The below constitutes a summary of such DCRA:

Through a DCRA with the College, BASSEM ABDEL-RAHMAN, #113,749 (the “**Registrant**”), acknowledged and admitted that their behaviour constituted unprofessional conduct. Particulars of the Registrant’s unprofessional conduct arises from one (1) complaint to the College include the following:

- In 2023, the Registrant failed to uphold medication administration standards when they administered 15 mg of morphine instead of the scheduled 5 mg dose of morphine, and/or one (1) or more employer policies.
- In 2023, the Registrant failed to uphold medication administration standards when they failed to document, report, or monitor a patient, after administering 15 mg of morphine instead of the scheduled 5 mg dose of morphine, and/or one (1) or more employer policies; and
- In 2023, the Registrant failed to demonstrate adequate knowledge, skill, or judgement, when they considered performing one (1) or more improper catheterization procedures.

The Registrant agreed to complete course work for medication management and documentation in nursing and provide a practice report letter. Conditions shall appear on the College register and on the Registrant’s practice permit.
