

DISCIPLINARY COMPLAINT RESOLUTION AGREEMENT

pursuant to section 55(2)(a.1) of the *Health Professions Act*

BETWEEN:

STEPHANIE KOMM, #66,915
(the “**Registrant**”)

and

College of Registered Nurses of Alberta
(the “**College**”)

A Disciplinary Complaint Resolution Agreement (“**DCRA**”) was executed between the Registrant and the College, dated with effect November 21, 2024. The below constitutes a summary of such DCRA:

Through an Agreement with the College, STEPHANIE KOMM, #66,915 (the “**Registrant**”), acknowledged and admitted that their behaviour constituted unprofessional conduct. Particulars of the Registrant’s unprofessional conduct arises from one (1) complaint to the College include the following:

- On or around March 20, 2024, and March 23, 2024, the Registrant failed to demonstrate adequate judgement when they diverted medication from their employment setting, and one (1) or more employer policies.

The Registrant agreed to complete coursework in responsible nursing, pay a fine, and provide employer references covering a total of 660 hours of nursing practice. Finally, prior to commencing employment and returning to nursing practice, the Registrant must provide medical clearance from a treating physician. Conditions shall appear on the College register and on the Registrant’s practice permit.
