

**AMENDED AMENDED DISCIPLINARY COMPLAINT  
RESOLUTION AGREEMENT**

pursuant to section 55(2)(a.1) of the *Health Professions Act*

**BETWEEN:**

**HEIDI LAWTON, #52,801**  
(the “**Registrant**”)

and

**College and Association of Registered Nurses of Alberta**  
**also known as College of Registered Nurses of Alberta**  
(the “**College**”)

An Amended Amended Disciplinary Complaint Resolution Agreement (“**AADCRA**”) was executed between the Registrant and the College, dated with effect **APRIL 11, 2022**. The below constitutes a summary of such AADCRA:

Through an AADCRA with the College, HEIDI LAWTON, #52,801 (the “**Registrant**”), acknowledged and admitted that their behaviour constituted unprofessional conduct. Particulars of the Registrant’s unprofessional conduct arises from one (1) complaint to the College include the following:

- The Registrant failed to practice with honesty, integrity and respect and failed to practice competently when they stole percocet tablets on ninety-one occasions while in the position of assistant head nurse and falsified narcotic records.

The Registrant was suspended for thirty (30) days and was required to complete course work on ethics, medication administration and documentation. The Registrant was restricted to practice as a RN in a limited practice setting, specifically administering vaccines for approximately one (1) year. Furthermore, arising from a period of non-compliance, the Registrant is required to pay a \$500.00 fine to the College. Conditions shall appear on the College register and on the Registrant’s practice permit.
