

DISCIPLINARY COMPLAINT RESOLUTION AGREEMENT

pursuant to section 55(2)(a.1) of the *Health Professions Act*

BETWEEN:

KARYN STITZENBERGER, #76,317
(the “**Registrant**”)

and

College of Registered Nurses of Alberta
(the “**College**”)

A Disciplinary Complaint Resolution Agreement (“**DCRA**”) was executed between the Registrant and the College, dated with effect June 17, 2024. The below constitutes a summary of such DCRA:

Through a Agreement with the College, Karyn Stitzenberger, #76,317 (the “**Registrant**”), acknowledged and admitted that their behaviour constituted unprofessional conduct. Particulars of the Registrant’s unprofessional conduct arises from one (1) complaint to the College and includes the following:

- On or around the night shift of April 28, 2020, the Registrant failed to demonstrate reasonable judgement when they brought alcohol to work for the purpose of consumption.
- On or around the night shift of April 28, 2020, the Registrant failed to adequately assess their fitness to practice when practicing as a RN when they did the following:
 - Brought alcohol to work for the purpose of consumption

The Registrant agreed to complete coursework on professionalism and responsible nursing. The Registrant must provide a letter from physician confirming fitness to practice as well as submit Employer References. Conditions shall appear on the College register and on the Registrant’s practice permit.
