



DISCIPLINARY COMPLAINT RESOLUTION AGREEMENT
pursuant to section 55(2)(a.1) of the *Health Professions Act*

BETWEEN:

JANINA BOJANINI GENTILE #94,245
(the “Regulated Member”)

and

The College and Association of Registered Nurses of Alberta
(“CARNA”)

A Disciplinary Complaint Resolution Agreement (“**DCRA**”) was executed between the Regulated Member and CARNA, dated with effect **JUNE 18, 2021**. The below constitutes a summary of such DCRA:

Through a DCRA with CARNA, Janina Bojanini Gentile #94,245 (the “**Registrant**”), acknowledged and admitted that their behaviour constituted unprofessional conduct. Particulars of the Registrant’s unprofessional conduct arises from one (1) complaint to CARNA include the following:

- Between approximately November 2019 and October 2020, the Registrant failed to practice with honesty, integrity and respect when they made numerous narcotic withdrawals that they diverted from their employer; and
- Between approximately November 2019 and October 2020, the Registrant accessed the personal health information of patients for purposes inconsistent with their professional responsibilities when they accessed patient charts for purposes related to diverting narcotics from their employer.

The Registrant agreed to serve a six (6) month suspension, complete course work on professionalism in nursing, pay a \$1,000.00 fine, and provide employer(s) notifications of the DCRA for two (2) years. Conditions shall appear on the CARNA register and on the Registrant’s practice permit
